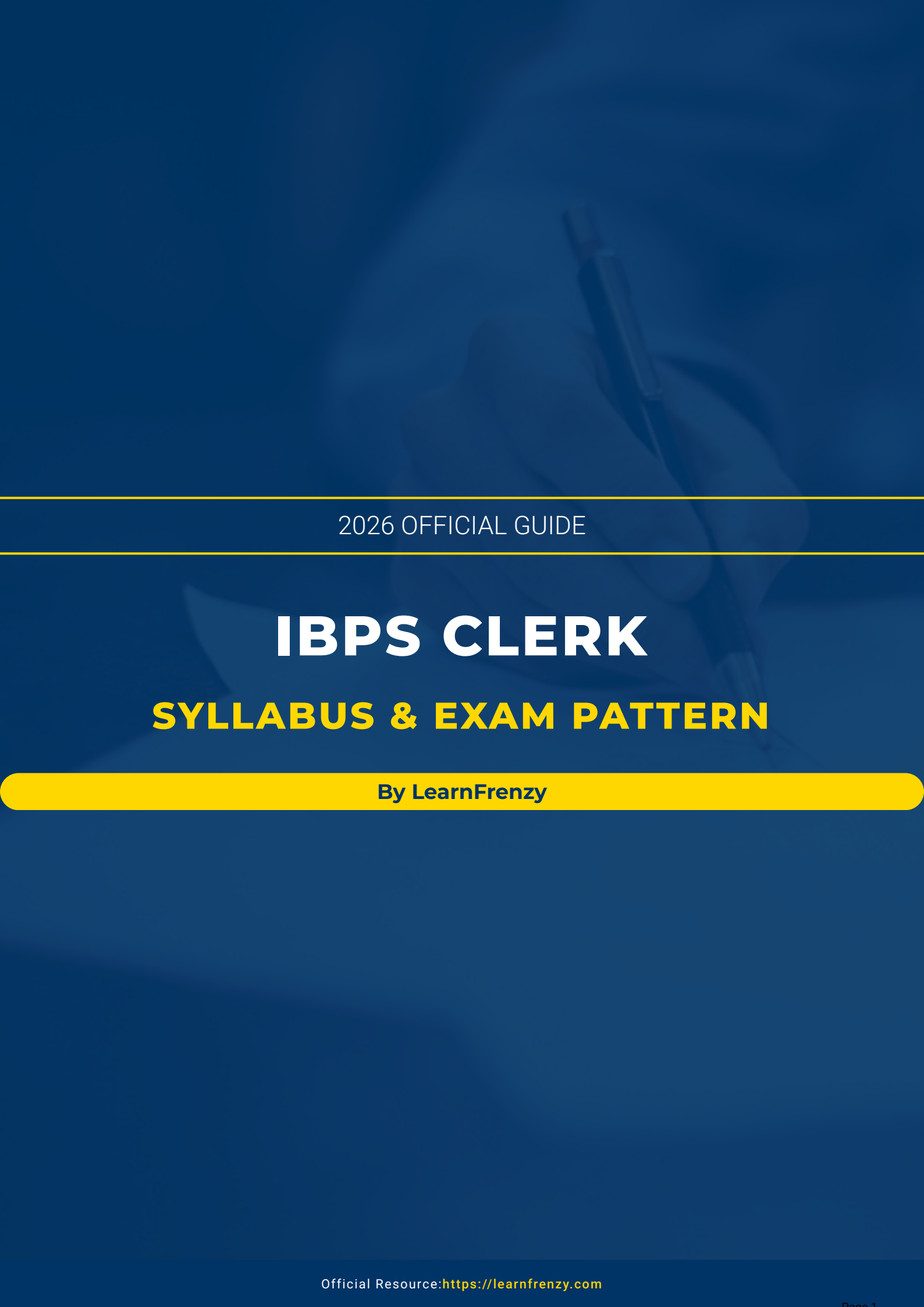

IBPS Clerk Syllabus 2026

The IBPS Clerk 2026 syllabus for Prelims covers English Language, Numerical Ability, and Reasoning Ability, focusing on topics like reading comprehension, simplification, and puzzles to test speed and accuracy.

In Mains, it expands to General/Financial Awareness, General English, Reasoning Ability & Computer Aptitude, and Quantitative Aptitude, emphasising current affairs, data interpretation, and banking awareness for deeper evaluation. Understanding this structure helps aspirants prioritise high-weightage areas and align preparation with the bilingual computer-based exam format.

The Preliminary exam comprises three sections. The question paper contains 100 questions with a maximum score of 100. DI is a primary focus in Quant, while Puzzles dominate the Reasoning section.

Language Proficiency Test (LPT)

- **Purpose:** Conducted to assess language skills for candidates who cleared Mains.
- **Nature:** It is a Qualifying Test (Essential to clear for selection).
- **Focus:** Evaluates proficiency in the official language of the applied state.
- **Syllabus:** Reading comprehension, writing ability, grammar, and basic conversation in regional language.
- **Tasks:** Writing letters, essays, or passages in the local dialect.

Note: Failure to qualify in the LPT results in disqualification, regardless of the marks obtained in the Mains examination.
