Subject: Combined Graduate Level (CGL) Examination, 2025 - Declaration of First Round of Tentative Allocation (FRTA)–reg.

Result of Tier-I of Combined Graduate Level Examination, 2025 was declared on 18.12.2025. Thereafter, Tier-II of the Examination was conducted in the Computer Based Mode on 18.01.2026 and 19.01.2026.

2. First Round of Tentative Allocation (FRTA) has been done in accordance with the Notice dated 03.03.2026 on introduction of Sliding Mechanism for qualifying candidates.

3. As per Para 16.6 of the Notice of the Examination, based on the aggregate performance in Section-I and Section-II of Paper-I of Tier-II Examination, candidates have been shortlisted for evaluation of Section-III i.e. Computer Knowledge Test (CKT) and Section-IV i.e. Data Entry Speed Test (DEST) for all posts. The candidates, who did not qualify in Section-I + Section-II, were not eligible for evaluation of Section-III. The cut-off details and candidates available for all posts for further selection process are as follows: -

4. In accordance with the Important Notice No. HQ-C11018/1/2025-C-1 dated 06.03.2026 and 12.03.2026 of the Commission, only those candidates who submitted their Option-cum-preferences online and also qualified in Section-I + Section-II for evaluation of Section-III & Section-IV have been considered for further selection process.

5. As per the Notice of Examination, qualifying in Tier-II, Paper-I, Section-III i.e. Computer Knowledge Test (CKT) and Section-IV i.e. Data Entry Speed Test (DEST) is essential for qualifying for FRTA. Section-III and Section-IV are of qualifying nature.

6. As per Paras 16.1 and 16.2 of the Notice of the Examination, following are the minimum qualifying marks and maximum percentage of errors-

a) Minimum qualifying marks in Section-I, Section-II and Section-III (CKT) of Paper-I and Paper-II of Tier-II Examination are as follows:

- (i) UR: 30%
- (ii) OBC/ EWS: 25%
- (iii) All other categories: 20%

b) Maximum percentage of errors allowed in Section-IV (DEST) of Paper-I of Tier-II Examination is as follows:

- (i) UR: 20%
- (ii) OBC/ EWS: 25%
- (iii) All other categories: 30%.

9. As per the provisions of the Notice of Examination, allocation of posts to eligible candidates has been made on the basis of merit-cum-preference of posts submitted by the candidates online. The Commission had published a list of total 15125 final vacancies of CGLE

2025 on the website of the Commission on 06.03.2026. Owing to some administrative reasons, Department of Posts and Ministry of Electronics & Information Technology have revised their vacancies for the post of Accountant/Junior Accountant and Assistant Section Officer respectively as under:

- a. Revised Vacancies of Accountant/ Junior Accountant: 70 (UR-42, SC-11, ST-04, OBC-10, EWS-03 including ESM-00, VH-01 & HH-01)
- b. Revised Vacancies of Assistant Section Officer: 03 (UR-02 & ST-01)

Accordingly, the **final vacancies are 15,118.**

15. In compliance of Order dated 23.02.2026 of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in SLP (C) No. 7246/2026, any allocation/appointments made which are the subject matter of the *lis* under consideration of the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi in WP (C) No. 1733/2026 titled as Pramod Kumar Rai and Ors. Vs. Union of India and Ors, shall be subject to the final outcome of the said Writ Petition.

16. In pursuance of Para 15.4 of Notice of examination, the Commission vide Notice dated 03.03.2026, has introduced a 'Sliding Mechanism' to ensure maximum filling of vacancies in a given examination cycle, provide fair and merit-based opportunities to candidates and minimize the unfilled vacancies arising from absenteeism of the candidates who are opting for non-joining in the given examination cycle. The mechanism aims to establish a single round of reallocation process for the unutilized vacancies.

Accordingly, the candidates are to choose the venue, date and slot for sliding process by logging in through the designated login module on the website of the Commission (<https://ssc.gov.in/>) **from 8th April, 2026 to 10th April, 2026**. Thereafter, the sliding process will be **conducted at the cities of the concerned Regional Offices from 13th to 22nd April, 2026 (Northern Region) and from 13th to 18th April, 2026 (all the other Regional Offices)**. The address of venue for Sliding process will be made available at the designated login module on the website of the Commission (<https://ssc.gov.in/>) while choosing the venue, date and slot for sliding process. **Any candidate failing to attend the sliding process physically will be treated as absent and will not be considered for the final result.** Recommended candidates of Combined Graduate Level Examination, 2025 (Paper-II) in FRTA are also advised to go through the Notice dated 08.04.2026 on Sliding Mechanism and various notices issued in this regard on the Commission's website.

17. Representations received from the candidates with regard to the Answer Keys of Tier-II Examination have been carefully examined and the Answer Keys have been modified wherever necessary. Final answer keys have been used for evaluation.
